**d) *What is the cost of the Sustainable@EDU SOLUTIONS?***

The cost of ***Sustainable@EDU SOLUTIONS*** depends on the specific conditions of each ***Sustainable@EDU PROJECT*** and aims to provide a smart affordable solution.
